Cost Perf. Index (CPI)	EV / AC	> 1	< 1
Schedule Perf. Index (SPI)	EV / PV	> 1	< 1
Estimate at Completion (EAC)	BAC / CPI	Lower than BAC	Higher than BAC
Estimate to Complete (ETC)	$EAC - AC$	—	—
Variance at Completion (VAC)	$BAC - EAC$	Positive	Negative
TCPI	$(BAC - EV) / (BAC - AC)$	< 1 (easy)	> 1 (hard)

Eliminate	Avoid — eliminate the threat	Exploit — ensure it happens
Transfer	Transfer — shift to 3rd party	Share — allocate to best-able party
Reduce/Increase	Mitigate — reduce probability/impact	Enhance — increase probability/impact
Do Nothing	Accept — acknowledge the risk	Accept — take advantage if it occurs
Outside Scope	Escalate — outside project scope	Escalate — outside project scope

AGILE / HYBRID KEY CONCEPTS

Concept	Description
Servant Leadership	PM supports the team, removes impediments, facilitates — doesn't command
Sprint / Iteration	Timeboxed cycle (1–4 weeks). Plan → Execute → Review → Retrospect
Product Backlog	Prioritized list of work owned by Product Owner. Refined continuously
Daily Standup	15-min sync: what I did, what I'll do, blockers. Not a status report
Retrospective	Team reflects on process improvements. Happens every sprint
Definition of Done	Shared checklist for "complete." Agreed by team, not imposed
Velocity	Average story points per sprint. Used for planning, not performance eval
Kanban	Visual flow management. WIP limits, pull-based, continuous delivery
Hybrid Approach	Mix of predictive + agile. Most real projects. Tailor to context
Empirical Process	Transparency → Inspection → Adaptation. Foundation of Scrum

EXAM DAY QUICK TIPS

- Think 'PMI mindset' — choose the by-the-book answer, not what you'd do in real life
- Read keywords carefully: FIRST, NEXT, BEST, MOST, LEAST change the correct answer
- Eliminate wrong answers first — usually 2 are clearly wrong, choose between remaining 2
- ~76 seconds per question — mark difficult ones and come back
- All changes go through formal change control (even 'small' ones on the exam)
- When in doubt: communicate with stakeholders, follow the process, lead as a servant
- Hybrid is the default mindset — ask 'which approach fits THIS situation?'
- Business Environment is 26% — don't skip it. Know benefits realization and org change
